


ARE THROUGH THE SHOWDAY

ONLINE SOFTWARE

How to enter:

1. Go to <https://showday.online/>

2. Click the  button



3. Click the   button down the bottom of the log in box

4. Enter your details

5. Click    “Open Entries” then look for the Merredin Show.

(Please note, our show will not be live until February 2026, you will not be able to find us until then).

6. Locate the section you are entering in on the side menu (for example only:   >)

7. Complete your entries (if you need help, please watch the instructional video through the QR code below)

8. Make payment through the site.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

ENTRY FEE: \$3.00 per goat per class.

Animals must be bona fide property of the exhibitor.

Diseased, lame, vermin infested and sick in appearance animals WILL NOT be accepted for exhibition and will be removed immediately from the grounds.

Dairy goats must be registered with Dairy Goats Society of Australia

Dairy Goats are to be CAE Negative - Proof of CAE status to be submitted with entry.

Waybills to be handed to steward on arrival.

The judge's decision WILL BE FINAL

ANY VERBAL AND PHYSICAL ABUSE TOWARDS ANYONE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. ANYONE CAUGHT DOING THIS WILL BE REMOVED ALONG WITH THEIR ANIMALS IMMEDIATELY WITHOUT WARNING.

All animals to be ready for judging by 9.30am on show day. Ring number I is allocated for Dairy goats.

No changes to entries on the day of the show.

All reasonable care will be taken of the exhibits, but no responsibility will be incurred by Merredin & Districts Agricultural Society Inc.

Theft of animals will result in life disqualification from any future events.

ANY person seen mishandling animals will be asked to leave the grounds. Ill treatment of animals WILL NOT be tolerated.

It is the responsibility of the owners to feed and water their animals.

Camping will be available on grounds for those that wish to use them. The Merredin Recreation Centre will have toilets and shower available for use. Please request a Camping Form.
